

Legislated Deadlines for the Iowa Core Curriculum

According to legislation, district and accredited non-public schools must:

1. Respond to outcomes and targets of the Implementation Plan

- Due July 1, 2010, for grades 9-12
- Due July 1, 2012, for grades K-8

2. Complete an initial alignment of local content with the Iowa Core Curriculum Essential Concepts and Skill Sets in Literacy, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and 21st Century Skills (Civic Literacy, Health Literacy, Financial Literacy, Technology Literacy, and Employability Skills) and identify steps to address any gaps.

- Due July 1, 2012, for grades 9-12
- Due 2012-2014, for grades K-8

3. Complete initial analysis of professional development needs in the areas of instruction and assessment and integrate into the District Professional Development Plan (following CSIP procedure).

- Due July 1, 2012, for grades 9-12
- Due 2013-2014, for grades K-8
