### Decisions on TAB Activities for 2008-09:

- Definitely proceed on the update of the TAB Community Resource brochure (Kathy Anson will provide leadership on this.) Complete by early fall 2008.
- September 23 or 30, 2008: Offer a TAB awareness event for the new work experience coordinators from the 2-county area.
- November 18: Offer a Person-Centered Futures Planning Workshop, to be held in DeWitt or Clinton.
- Winter/Spring 2009: Offer Lunch & Learn opportunities for teachers on topics such as (1) post-secondary educational options (2) Supported Employment, Waivers & Consumer Choices Option (3) Housing and Transportation. No specific decisions on dates or topics were made. Clinton Comm. College Graphic Arts and Technology Center was suggested as a possible location.
- We will continue to discuss transportation issues at TAB, but not take on a specific project. We will try to keep ourselves informed of efforts and advocacy opportunities that TAB could support or promote to improve transportation availability for persons with disabilities.
- If the AEA decides to offer a course for re-certification credit related to transition, Jane will call upon TAB members to assist in presenting information on community resources.
