Presentation of the I-JAG Program:

The I-JAG program is a comprehensive career exploration, employability and life skills program for high school students (10-12th grade) facing social, cultural and educational barriers to support them in graduating from high school and continuing their education and employment opportunities. Some of the services I-JAG offers includes: classroom instruction, employability skills training, individualized career planning, adult mentoring, job and postsecondary placement, linkage to school and community based services and 12 months of follow up services post graduation.

I-JAG currently runs at Davenport North High School and will be district wide in Davenport (to include Central and West High Schools) starting the fall of 2008. The program is 70% funded through Iowa Workforce Development and other grants and private donations.
