

The Mississippi Bend AEA will be offering Instructional Practices Inventory (IPI) walk-through training to interested administrators either October 19, 2006, (middle school/high school training) or October 20, 2006, (elementary training). Jerry Valentine will be the trainer. The one-day hands-on workshop will transition from a discussion of the IPI student engagement categories to skill development in the documentation of categories. Each participant will complete a brief skill assessment at the conclusion of the workshop and will receive copies of materials necessary to use IPI in his/her respective school. A data computation file will also be provided so that trained school administrators can enter and print their own school profile charts for study and discussion.

There is no registration fee for administrators in the AEA 9 region. You will have the option of purchasing lunch/snacks or having lunch-on-your-own; lunch will be limited to one-half hour.

The MBAEA requires that you provide us with IPI implementation data collected a minimum of 2 times during the school year (suggested months: November and February). This implementation data will include: (1) a copy of the data collected, and (2) a brief reflection that addresses

- (a) How the data was presented to staff, and
- (b) Changes implemented, if any, as a result of the walk-through
